Designed to be a celebration of apprenticeships including the best apprentices and apprentice employers within the Liverpool City Regions of Halton, Knowsley, Liverpool, Sefton, St Helens and Wirral.

Liverpool City Region Apprentice of the Year

For each of the six regions:

Halton Apprentice of the Year
Knowsley Apprentice of the Year
Liverpool Apprentice of the Year
Sefton Apprentice of the Year
St Helens Apprentice of the Year
Wirral Apprentice of the Year

Entry Criteria:

If you are currently undertaking an apprenticeship, or have completed one in the last 6 months, within a business in the Liverpool City Region, then this is an award for you. We are looking for apprentices that have embraced their apprenticeship and taken the opportunity available to them to progress their learning and self-development. The judges are also looking for an apprentice that shows a passion for their chosen apprenticeship and has provided a real benefit to their employer.

Terms of entry:

1. Apprentices can be of any age currently in or having completed an apprenticeship in the last 6 months.
2. All apprentices must be or have been registered with a recognisable apprenticeship programme.
3. All apprentices must live in the Liverpool City Region.
4. All applications will be required to provide a supporting statement from their employer.
5. Apprentices may only enter one of the regions' categories.

For each of the six regions:

Liverpool Apprenticeship Employer of the Year Award
Sefton Apprenticeship Employer of the Year Award

Wirral Apprenticeship Employer of the Year Award

Entry Criteria:

If your business has a strong commitment to employing, nurturing and supporting apprentices and currently have an apprentice or apprentices working for you then this an award for you. Judges will be looking for an employer that can show the measurable benefits apprentices have provided their company. They will also be looking for examples of best practice and the support put in place to help the development of apprentices within the workplace.

Terms of entry:

1. Employers must have employed 1 or more apprentices for a minimum of 12 months.
2. All employers must be located in their chosen region or be able to provide evidence of true contribution to the region.
3. All applications will be required to provide a supporting statement from an apprentice under their employment.
4. All employers must be registered with a recognisable apprenticeship provider.
5. Employers may only enter one of the regions categories.
